The wine is attractively fruited and elegantly fragrant on the nose showing nectarine, ripe apple, mandarin and floral characters with subtle spicy complexity. The palate is succulent and beautifully rounded, delivering bright fruit flavours backed by fine texture and vibrant acidity, finishing refreshing and very tasty.

Bright, light golden hued yellow colour with some depth, a little lighter on the rim. The nose is rounded but firmly packed with aromas of savoury white stonefruits interwoven with nutty lees and oak detail, along with a subtle amalgam of minerals and herbs. This has good vinous presence. Dry to taste and medium-full bodied, the palate has rich and concentrated flavours of white stonefruits and nuts and floral elements. The fruit forms a good core with depth and intensity, yet has a rounded accessibility. The mouthfeel has a light phenolic grip and integrated acidity, and the wine carries to a moderately long finish of stonefruits and florals. This is a fulsome dry Pinot Gris with stonefruit, nutty and floral flavours on a palate with good vinous presence.
