Bright pale strawberry pink colour with slight purple hues, lighter on the rim. The nose is very fresh, bright and full with a firm core of strawberries and cream entwined with red floral notes. Dryish to taste and medium-bodied, the palate has a finely concentrated core with sweet flavours of strawberries and cream melded with floral and confectionary elements, and some fresh fermentation esters. The mouthfeel is juicy and lush, and is balanced by racy, thirst-quenching acidity. The wine flows along a very fine-textured line, leading to a lingering finish of strawberries and cream, and confectionary, with a little grip.
