It is immediately appealing on the nose showing fresh pear, mango, fig and floral characters with a touch of spicy complexity. The palate is succulent and beautifully rounded, offering delightful fruit intensity and smooth texture, finishing long and juicy.

The nose is fresh with full aromas of white stone fruit, acacia florals and nuances of honeysuckle with mineral suggestions. Off-dry to taste and medium-bodied, the palate has elegantly concentrated and up-front white stone fruit, white floral and honeyed flavours. This has good aromatic presence, and the wine flows with good vibrancy and energy along a fine-featured line, leading to a light, gently sweet finish. This is a moderately rich, up-front medium-dry Pinot Gris on a refreshing and lively palate. Serve as an aperitif and with Asian fare over the next 3 years.
