



Hāhā 2018 Hawke's Bay Pinot Gris

Variety

100% Pinot Gris.

Colour

Pale straw yellow with light green hues.

Aroma

Soft florals, mandarin, ripe apple and a subtle spicy complexity.

Palate

Off dry in style. Succulent lychee, pear and nectarine flavours, perfectly balanced acidity and a creamy mouthfeel.

Analysis

Alcohol	13.5%
pH	3.66
Titratable Acidity	5.6 g/l
Residual Sugar	4.2 g/l

Vineyard

The grapes are picked from vineyards in the Hawke's Bay high country of New Zealand. The soils are ancient river beds with a mix of free draining stony soils and clay loams.

Viticulture and Vinification

Vertical shoot positioned trellis was used with two canes pruned, providing an average of 11 tonnes per hectare.

Vintage

A warm and dry summer provided stunning flavours and structure.

Food Matching

This wine is delicious on its own, or with fresh fish or Asian cuisine.
