

# Hāhā 2018 Hawke's Bay Rosé

## Variety

90% Merlot, 10% Malbec

## Colour

Salmon pink

## Aroma

Beautifully fragrant with strawberry, lifted florals, and a hint of wild bramble on the nose.

## Palate

Bursting with red berries, florals and a hint of spice, this is an elegant Rosé with a lingering crisp, dry finish.

## Vineyard

This wine is produced from vineyards in the Hawke's Bay region of New Zealand. The soils are rocky ancient river beds with a mix of free draining stony soils and clay loams.

A combination of hand picked and machine harvested fruit, with minimal pressing on its skins.

## Vintage

A remarkable summer with cool evening temperatures and harvested early to ensure beautiful flavour and fruit intensity.
