

# Hāhā 2016 Reserve Marlborough Pinot Noir



## Variety

100% Pinot Noir, Clones 777, 667 and 115.

## Colour

Dark ruby-red wine.

## Aroma

Dark raspberries and black cherries blossom into floral notes and a spicy rich finish.

## Palate

Dark cherry, plum and raspberries are beautifully interwoven with nuances of savoury and spice on the palate, leading to a long, rich-fruited, textural finish.

## Analysis

## Vineyard

This wine is hand picked from specially selected vines on an idyllic vineyard in the Awatere Valley of Marlborough, New Zealand. Great care is taken with these precious grapes while hand harvesting. The soils are ancient river beds with free draining stony soils and silty clay loams.

## Viticulture and Vinification

Vertical shoot positioned trellis was used with cordon spur pruning, providing an average of 3.2 tonnes per acre.  
70% French Oak barrel aged for 12 months.

## Vintage

A long hot summer provided rich full flavours and great structure.

## Food Matching

This wine is perfect with lamb and venison, and is delicious with a slow-cooked ragu on pasta.
