

Hāhā 2017 Marlborough Chardonnay

Variety

100% Chardonnay

Colour

Lemon gold with soft yellow hues.

Aroma

Lifted apricot, citrus and nougat, with a hint of cedar complexity showing on the nose.

Palate

A delicious combination of white stonefruit, tangerine and pineapple is balanced with subtle oak and a finely textured palate.

Vineyard

This wine is produced from selected vineyards in the renowned Marlborough region of New Zealand. The soils are ancient river beds with a mix of free draining stony soils and clay loams.

Viticulture and Winemaking

All hand harvested fruit, 100% barrel fermented in French oak.

Vintage

After an early start to summer with warm weather leading to good flavour development, a longer and cooler vintage resulted in a smaller crop producing stunning flavours.
