

Hāhā 2017 Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc



Variety

Sauvignon Blanc

Colour

Soft golden colour with light green hues.

Aroma

Intensely aromatic with a blend of gooseberries, tropical fruit and capsicum on the nose.

Palate

A burst of concentrated gooseberry, lime and passionfruit leads to superb fruit richness and a crisp dry finish.

Vineyard

This wine is produced from vineyards in the Waihopai Valley and the Wairau Valley of the stunningly beautiful Marlborough region of New Zealand. The soils are ancient river beds with a mix of free draining stony soils and clay loams.

Vintage

A remarkable season featuring an early warm summer followed by stints of wind and rain. This resulted in a smaller crop providing good flavour development and a lovely structure.

Food Matching

This wine is delicious as an aperitif and with long lunches. Enjoy with steamed green lipped mussels or a green chicken curry.
