Bright and attractively fruited, the inviting bouquet shows Black Dorris plum, blueberry compote, violet, mixed spice and toasted nut characters. The palate is fruit expressive and fleshy with a silky mouthfeel and a lingering smooth finish. Immediately appealing with sweet berry flavours and supple texture.

Dark, even ruby-red colour with purple hues, a little lighter on the rim, very youthful in appearance. The nose is softly full with up-front ripe fruit aromas of dark plums with boysenberry, blueberry and blackberry fruit, and an amalgam of violet florals, jam and a little confectionary. The aromatics are primary, uncomplicated, and accessible. Medium-bodied, the palate has rich, un-front, and uncomplicated, sweet and luscious flavours of ripe dark plums, a little liquorice along with boysenberries and blueberry jam, along with fragrant florals, and confectionary notes. The mouthfeel is soft and supported by light, supple tannins with integrated acidity. The flavours carry to a long, juicy, sweet finish with light textural grip.
