It's fabulously fruited and inviting on the nose showing ripe peach, mango, vanilla and roasted hazelnut characters with a hint of brioche complexity. The palate is beautifully weighted and rounded, displaying bright fruit flavours together with elegant oak nuances, finishing long and creamy.

Fruity, fleshy and engaging bouquet with aromas of peaches and yellow apples, light brown baking spices and cashew nut, a hint of butter and cream. On the palate – juicy, fleshy, fruity and creamy. Flavours of peach and apple, some grapefruit and lemon zest, baking spices and mild toasty oak moments. Clean, balanced and well-made, medium-plus weight with a nice level of acidity.
