

ROSÉ HAWKE'S BAY 2023

VINTAGE OVERVIEW

Despite the challenges of the 2023 growing season, the 2023 vintage was an excellent one for Rosé in Hawke's Bay and has resulted in one of our most exciting wines yet! Cool conditions throughout the summer coupled with a destructive tropical cyclone meant it was a year for viticultural prowess and winemaking finese.

KEY VINEYARDS

Our Rosé is made from a blend of Merlot and Malbec grapes from vineyards mainly in the Bridge Pa sub-region in Hawke's Bay.

WINEMAKING

Following harvest in the middle of March, the grapes were processed with minimal pressing on skins to give just a touch of colour. A temperature controlled fermentation with selected yeast strains helped to preserve the aromatics.

TASTING NOTES

Bursting with aromatic notes of watermelon, strawberry and lifted florals on the nose, followed through with juicy red fruit flavours and a hint of spice on the palate. An elegant Rosé with a lingering moreish dry finish that will leave you wanting more.
